GINGIVAL RETRACTION GEL



Product Description: Hemostal Gel is a 25% Aluminum Chloride Gel intended to be used to restrict and stop bleeding and control fluids in the sulcus surrounding the tooth during dental procedure in the mouth **Composition:** Aluminum Chloride, Glycerine, Fillers, Coloring Pigment, Flavoring agents & Purified

Water.

Intended Purpose / Intended Use: It is used as a topical hemostatic agent to contact gingival bleeding. Indications for Use: Restrict and stop bleeding during restorative procedures, Crown preparations & oral prophylaxis

Instructions for use: Remove the cap from syringe and fix applicator tip. Apply a sufficient amount of gel directly into the sulcus, carefully following the contour of the prepared tooth. Leave in place for 2 minutes. In case bleeding persists, wash off the gel and re-apply and wait for 2 minutes. Rinse gently, dry and take the impression. For Sulcus retraction, the gel impregnated retraction cord should be carefully placed stepwise in the gingival sulcus with the help of a cord. The dispensed material shall not be placed back in container and the dose once applied and used shall not be reused.

Warnings:

- 1. Device to be used by a qualified dentist only.
- 2. Do not inject the material.
- 3. For topical use in dental operatory for control of bleeding only.

Precautions:

- 1. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not take internally.
- Eye contact If the product comes in contact with eyes, if may cause irritation. Rinse immediately with water and seak medical attention.
- 3. Skin contact Avoid contact with skin, it may cause skin sensitization. Wipe off throughly with cotton and then wash well with soap and water.

Contraindications:

- 1. Do not use the product if the patient is allergic to any of its ingredients.
- 2. Not to be used for contact of bleeding during surgical extraction of teeth.

Storage Conditions: Store at temperature between 10°C(50°F) to 24°C(75°F). Close the cap carefully after use. Keep away from moisture. Shelf life not affected after opening if stored in a cool dry place.

Shelf Life: 3 years from the date of manufacturing.
