Composition: Aluminium Chloride, Glycerine, Purified Water and Excipients.

Intended Purpose / Intended Use: It is used as a topical hemostatic agent to control ainaival bleedina.

Indication for Use: Restrict and stop bleeding during restorative procedures. Crown preparations & oral prophylaxis

Instructions for Use: Apply directly to the required place with saturated cotton pellet. The dispensed material shall not be placed back in container and the dose once applied and used shall not be reused.

Warnings: Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin (allergic contact dermatitis), and eyes. Avoid prolonged inhalation. Do not take internally. Contact with the skin may cause irritation, burns of hypersensitivity. If contact with skin occurs immediately wipe off thoroughly with cotton and alcohol and then wash well with soap and water. If skin rash and sensitization or other allergic reaction occurs discontinue use and seek medical attention. If the product comes into contact with the eyes, rinse thoroughly with fresh water and consult a physician.
